

## Shavlik Technologies Product Support Life Cycle

Shavlik Technologies has established a Product Support Policy that defines the level of support a given release receives as it moves through its life cycle to End of Life. The release numbers provided in the title of the software defines software versions. The Product Support Policy applies to the major release versions of software. Releases are defined as:

- **Major Release:** specified with an incremented number to the left of the decimal point, i.e. 4.0 to 5.0. Major releases add significant new functionality to the application, for example, agents where none were available previously.
- **Minor Release:** specified with an incremented number to the right of the decimal point, i.e. 4.2 to 4.3. Minor releases add some new functionality, but it provides incremental improvements to existing capabilities.
- **Point Release:** specified by an incremented digit to the right of the second decimal point, i.e. 5.8.0 to 5.8.1. Point releases mainly include fixes to issues found by our customer base or internally, but may also have minor feature improvements.

As a product release moves through its life cycle it is important to clearly define the level of support that will be provided to customers. The Product Support Policy defines this level of support based on the stage a release is in within its lifecycle.

The stages are:

<b>Current</b>	This is the most recent release of the product that is supported.
<b>Prior</b>	This is not the current release of the product, however, support may be available for this product and related data feeds for a period of time.
<b>Inactive</b>	Support for a prior release has ended.

The types of support for a given release are:

<b>Technical Support</b>	Provided by Shavlik's Product Support Team and related technical assistance websites.
<b>XML Updates</b>	Provided on the Shavlik website. Enables assessment and remediation functions for the selected product.
<b>Code Correction</b>	Provided for defects and critical issues.

**†Note2:** As of April 30<sup>th</sup>, 2010 Shavlik is announcing the official end of life for all v5.x versions. This means that customers running v5.8.0, v5.8.1 & v5.9 should plan to upgrade to v7.x before the end of April 2010.

**\*\*Note4:** NetChk Protect 7.5 is the last release that will support Windows NT4 as a supported platform for patch assessment and deployment.
